



SHIRE OF LAVERTON FENCING LOCAL LAW 2013

Undertakings to the Joint Standing Committee on Delegated Legislation

Following the gazettal of the *Shire of Laverton Fencing Local Law 2013* on 21 January 2014, the Shire of Laverton now provides the following undertakings to the Joint Standing Committee on Delegated Legislation (JSCDL):

1. The above Local Law was re-advertised by way of local Public Notice in the "*Kalgoorlie Miner*" on 30 April 2014 and also on Shire noticeboards on 28 April 2014. The Local Law came into operation on 4 February 2014.
2. *Australian Standard AS/NZS 3016:2002 Electrical installations – Electric security fences*:
Members of the public can access a copy of *AS/NZS 3016:2002 Electrical installations – Electric security fences* through the Shire if required.
3. As a result of a number of typographical errors in the published local law and also a factual error regarding clause 7.3, Council resolved on 17 April 2014 to make the *Shire of Laverton Fencing Amendment Local Law 2014* to correct these anomalies.
The Amendment Local Law was advertised for public comment on 10 May 2014. Submissions about the Amendment Local Law can be made up until 4:00pm on 1 July 2014.
4. At the time of posting this notice on its website, the Shire of Laverton also undertakes that where the Local Law is publicly available, whether in hard copy or electronic form, it will also be accompanied by a copy of this notice.
5. The Shire of Laverton also agreed to complete all of the above undertakings within six (6) months of the date of the April Ordinary Council Meeting (17 April 2014).
