Peter Crawford - Shire of Laverton

Andrew Barnes - Crescent Gold

Informed the meeting that a substantial amount of work lies ahead for Crescent Gold's Emergency Response Team to get up to a good standard. There is only limited resources/assets available and requested information on the resources available within the townsite. The settlement of the new owners, Focus Group, should happen within the next week.
